

## **Instructions for Presentation**

### **Each presentation must have:**

- Title of the inquiry, name of the researchers and name of school
- Research question
- Abstract i.e. brief summary of your work including, question, description of the methodology, data collection tools/sources of data, finding and conclusion. The abstract should give overview of the project.
- Introduction showing some background information and rationale of the study
- Method, complete and comprehensive detail is required to understand what you have done to find answer to your question. Tell what information you were looking for and why and how you went about finding the answer.
- Data and analysis, how you analysed the data. You can present the finding as graphs, charts, maps, images, anecdotes, interview, models etc. It should describe what data is saying.
- Conclusion, what interpretation you have drawn from the data you collected and analysed.
- Limitation, what were the limitations attached to your inquiry.
- One day before the presentation i.e. 23<sup>rd</sup> December 2011, you have to come to AKU-IED in the evening at 5 pm in order to set your project for presentation.

### **Criteria:**

- Originality, creativity and practicality in the idea
- Self explanatory
- Clarity and neatness in presentation
